Please note that you may only vote for SIX (6) OR FEWER candidates. Vote by placing a cross (x) in the block next to the candidate of your choice

Every Advocate who is on the Roll of Practising Advocates may vote for a maximum of six (6) candidates from the candidates listed below. In respect of the elections to be conducted, every practising Advocate who is admitted and enrolled as such may vote for the election of candidates. Please note that in order to comply with section 7(2)(a) of the Legal Practice Act, 2014 (Act No. 28 of 2014) and subject to the availability of the candidates, two (2) Black women, two (2) Black men, one (1) White woman and one (1) White man with the highest number of votes in their respective categories will constitute the six advocates who will serve as members of the South African Legal Practice Council ("Council").

“When constituting the Council the following factors must, as far as is practicable, be taken into account:

- (a) the racial and gender composition of South Africa;
- (b) the objects of the Council;
- (c) representation of persons with disabilities;
- (d) provincial representation; and
- (e) experience and knowledge of—
 - (i) the provision of legal services;
 - (ii) the principles of promoting access to justice;
 - (iii) legal education and training;
 - (iv) consumer affairs;
 - (v) civil and criminal proceedings and the functioning of the courts and tribunals in general;
 - (vi) the maintenance of professional standards of persons who provide legal services;
 - (vii) the handling of complaints; and
 - (viii) competition law.

NOTE:

The term “Black” has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003), read with the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment Act, 2013 (Act No. 46 of 2013) as a generic term which means Africans, Chinese, Coloureds and Indian/Asians who are citizens of the Republic of South Africa by birth or descent, or who became citizens of the Republic of South Africa by naturalisation before 27 April 1994 or on or after 27 April 1994 and who would have been entitled to acquire citizenship by naturalisation prior to that date and such other persons as may be categorised as black persons for purposes of that legislation.

NB: The *envelope* containing your Declaration Form and sealed *Ballot Paper* must be returned to the LPC and must be received by no later than **16h00 on 17-10-2024**. Late submissions will not be accepted. The delivery address of your Provincial Office of the LPC and selected Legal Aid South Africa offices to send your *Voting Papers* to is indicated in the table overleaf.

To assist Legal Practitioners who are unable to vote online or hand in a manual *Ballot Paper* to one of the LPC or selected Legal Aid Offices, we advise that you may also email your completed *Declaration Form* and *Ballot Papers* through to lpcelections2024@ince.co.za Both your *Declaration Form* and your *Ballot Paper* must be sent together when you email. *Ballot Papers* that are received without the *Declaration Form* and *vice versa* will be declared void and disregarded.

The emailed *Declaration Form* and *Ballot Paper* and must be received by no later than **16h00 on 17-10-2024**. Late submissions will not be accepted.
