1. Important information

(a) Personal URLs (PURL)¹

Each eligible practitioner will be provided with their own unique, personal URL, which will enable them to access the platform. It is important to note that **you may not share your unique, personal URL with any other practitioner** as it has been programmed to expect your specific SA ID number before a One Time Pin is issued as part of the login process.

(b) Mobile Networks and One Time Pins (OTP)

While the delivery of OTPs is normally quick to your mobile device, circumstances outside our control pertaining to the Mobile Networks can delay the delivery of OTPs. It is for this reason that the OTP is also sent to a practitioner's email address. If a practitioner keeps attempting to login before receiving their OTP, it is important to note that the newest OTP overwrites and cancels its predecessor.

(c) Time Out messages

The Nominations Platform has built-in security features that time out users after 5 minutes of no activity. If you get an error message that reads **Invalid CSRF Token, Form Ignored**, Members are then required to refresh their screen and login again.

(d) If you wish to review the candidates' bio details before logging in to vote

(e) Logging in and not completing your votes by logging out

The platform allows you to login, make voting selections and log out without submitting your final voting choices. When logging in a second time, should you not save your votes, the platform will display your previous selection(s) and you may proceed from where you left off.



2. Overview

This document explains the elections process using the LPC National Elections Platform accessed at <https://lpc.virtual-elections.online>. The platform is accessed by Legal Practitioners using their unique PURL² that is contained in the emailed invitation sent to them, advising that the LPC National Elections have opened.

3. How to login

Each communication that a practitioner receives from the LPC contains a unique PURL. Clicking on the link or PURL opens the primary login page. To proceed, insert your SA ID number.




Should you make an input error, you will receive an error message (see below), at which point you should input the correct ID number to continue.

You have entered an invalid Identity Number

Once a correct SA ID number is input, the platform will send a One Time Pin to your mobile device and email address as recorded by the LPC (see below).

Insert the OTP and hit **Enter** to continue (see examples of OTP below). The OTP is a six-digit number. Please note that the OTP has a limited life span, and if you refresh your browser and log on again before getting your OTP, the next OTP requested overwrites the previous one.

Depending on your professional designation, i.e. Attorney or Advocate, the platform will show you the electronic ballot paper you are entitled to cast votes on.



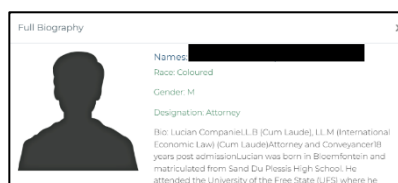

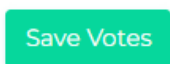
c) Voting for the maximum number of candidates

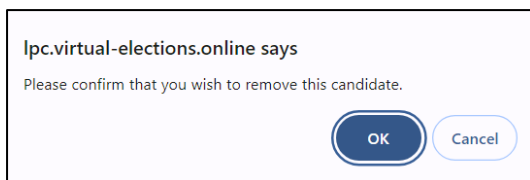


